EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER-19

The Court continues to monitor the COVID-19 pandemic and enters Orders as empirical data and changing circumstances dictate. The Court has reviewed regulations regarding travel restrictions in the United States of America. The Court modifies Emergency Administrative Order 1, subparagraph 11 to allow the payment and/or reimbursement of out-of-state travel for judicial employees and judges to those states that have lifted domestic travel restrictions. Emergency Administrative Order 1, subparagraph 11 remains in effect as to Alaska, Hawaii, Oregon, California, New Mexico, Kansas, Kentucky, New York, New Jersey, Vermont, Maine, Rhode Island, and the District of Columbia.
