WINNERS AWARDED AT EVERY SCHOOL! ART CONTEST RULES:

- **WIN \$100 FOR YOUR SCHOOL'S ART PROGRAM JUST FOR ENTERING.** All schools who submit 5 or more entries by the deadline of April 4 are eligible for a drawing. Eight eligible schools will be drawn as winners and will each be sent a \$100 check to go toward their art program.
- The art contest will be judged at each grade level (K - 12).
- 1st - 3rd place awards will be presented to winners in each grade, at each school. 1st place winners from each school will then be judged for statewide awards.
- Statewide winners will be presented with award certificates. Artwork will be displayed online and presented in the summer issue of *The Mississippi Lawyer* magazine.
- Artwork must be submitted via email and must be received by **Thursday, April 4, 2024**. See box at right.
- Artwork must be student's own work; no tracings, no glitter, no coloring pages where outlines are already provided.
- Artwork must reflect the theme – **"Voices of Democracy."**
- All mediums accepted. Creativity is awarded. Color is preferred.
- Each must be done on at least 8.5 x 11 paper.
- Organize multiple entries by school grade before submitting.
